Hi my name is Melissa Acevedo, Compliance Officer of the Cooperativa de Ahorro y Credito de Cabo Rojo, Puerto Rico. This are my suggestions about how to deal with the retailers.

- 1. Estabilsh a minimum profit in a fiscal year. Fincen should create a minimum profit, for example all the retailer whose revenue exceeds \$30,000 have to implement the compliance program.
- 2. Create an exempt to retailer who do not present any suspcious activity during the year and do not exceed the profit limit.
- 3. Every year the retailer has to present their financial statements and taxes or contributions report and complete a exempt designation form.
- 4. Visit the retailer perodically and monitore the account daily.

If the retailer fulfill this requirements they wont have to implement a compliance program. Or if the retailer do not fulfill all this requirements HAS to implement the compliance program.
